# Embedded Exit Survey Data

**Over a third** of the exit survey participants identify the content of the modules as **'new learning'**.

	Disengaged	Contributed to prior learning	Review prior learning	<b>New Learning</b>
% UG	4%	37%	7%	<b>26%</b>
% PG	2%	53%	2%	<b>42%</b>

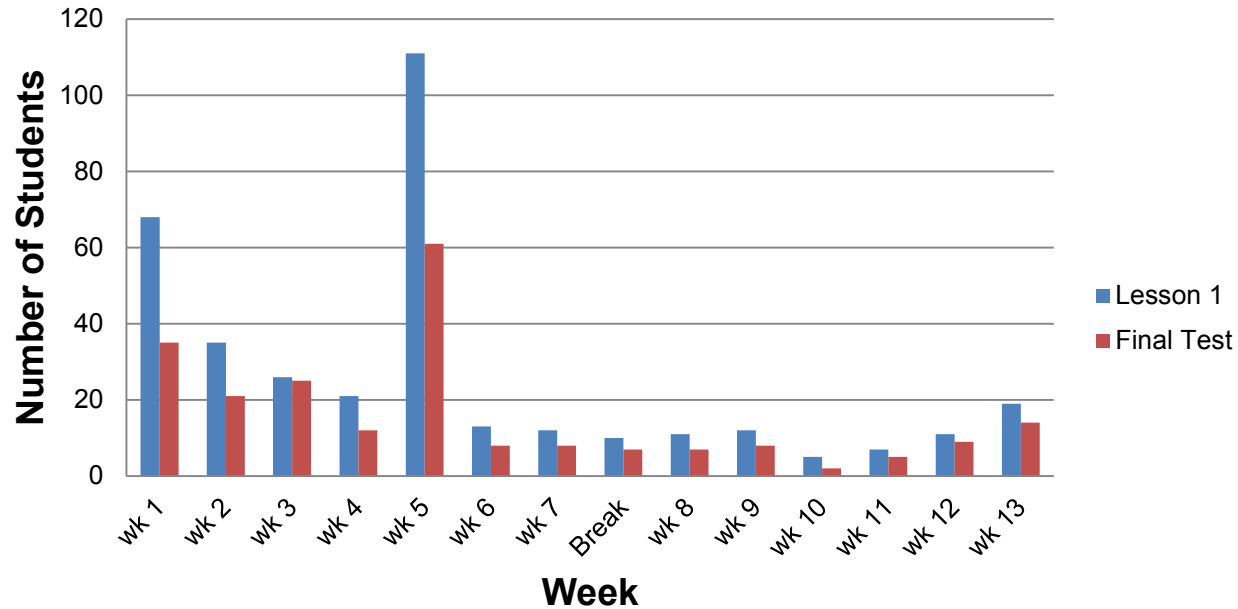

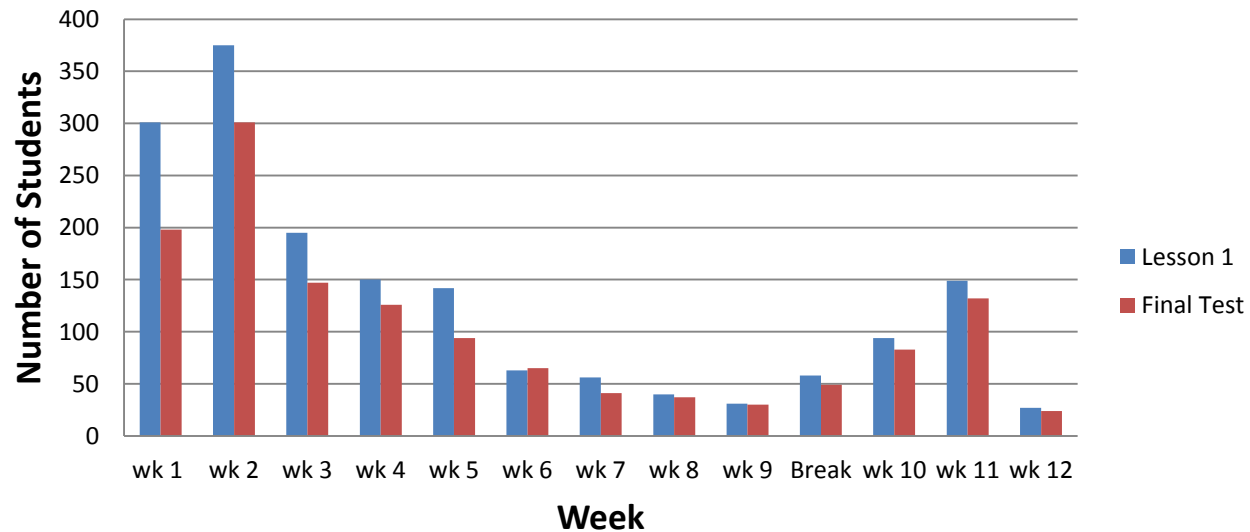

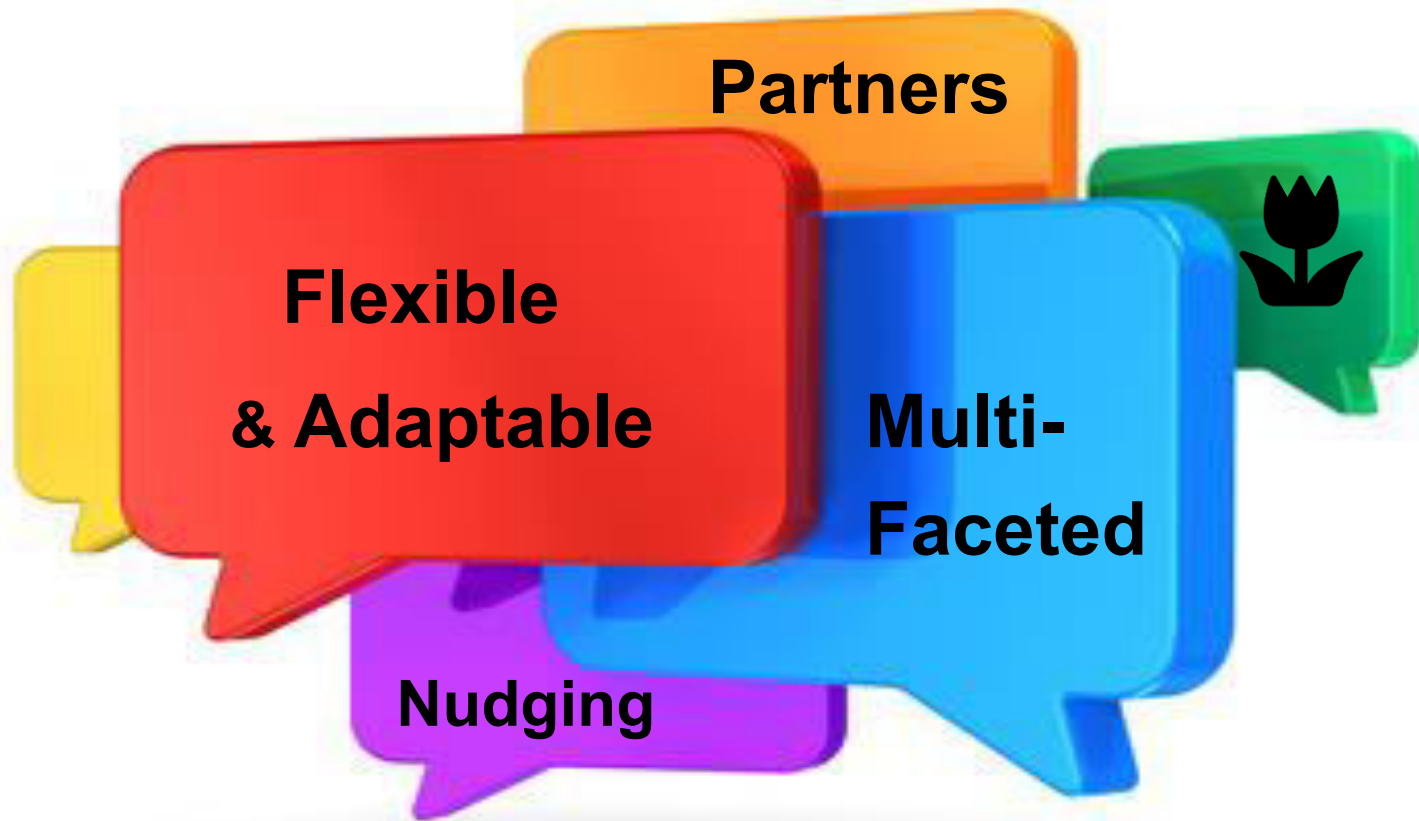
