For the May 5, 2020 election, applications will be accepted until the close of business on Friday, May 1, 2020, immediately preceding the election, except that, if the person wishes to receive the mail-in ballot by mail, the application shall be filed no later than the close of business on the 7th day before the election, April 28, 2020.

The Colorado Mail-In Voter Law requires that in order for your ballot to be counted it must be received by the DEO no later than 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election.
