The Coach will be selecting a New Zealand Masters team after the December trial. The trial will not only assess skating ability, expression of skill, leadership, fitness, and hockey sense but allow the player to gain the knowledge and understanding of what is required to excel and progress further into future potential National Masters teams. A few further players **may** be invited to training camps but this will be assessed after the December trial.

Coaching staff are looking forward to having the opportunity to provide high calibre coaching to all participants.

The opportunities to represent New Zealand is available to anyone who wishes to work hard, show a good attitude and most importantly be coachable in a team environment.

There is an expectation that players selected for the team attend each training camp and adhere to all fitness requirements as directed by the Coach. Further details will be provided upon team selection.

Important Information:

Upon arrival at each camp please check in with the Manager and Coach. Anyone who cannot make the sessions must advise management prior to the each camp.

All participants are dressed and ready to take the rink at least 10mins prior to the on-rink times as per the schedule

All players are to bring both light and dark jerseys to each training session.

Please ensure you bring your drink bottle to the bench at each training session. Hydration is important.

The Management and Coaching staff reserve the right to remove any person from the camp at any stage should behaviour be outside of that of what is expected and acceptable. This may be for a session or for the remainder of the camp

"H&S and Code of Conduct" regulations of each rink will apply.

All accommodation, food and snacks are to be provided by yourselves, no provision has been made to cater for players.

The changing rooms are to be kept clean at all times. Please ensure all rubbish, food wrappings, food waste and used tape is left in the rubbish bins or taken away and not left on the floor

The Coach and Management staff are trained and will attend to any first aid needs should there be a need
