WILDCARD APPLICATIONS for NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Club teams who wish to be considered for WILDCARD entries for National Championships should declare their interest immediately in writing to the NZIHA. Based on information received from regional committees there may be wildcard opportunities in the following grades:

Under 10 (1 team) will give 6 teams in total

Under 12 (1 team) will give 6 teams in total

Under 14 (1 team) will give 8 teams in total

Under 16 (2 teams) will give 8 teams in total

Under 18 (2 teams) will give 8 teams in total

Premier (to be advised)

Senior (possibly two 3rd placed teams) to give 8 teams in total

Women (Accept all teams to give 5 in total)

Applications for WILDCARDS will be accepted from club secretaries and close on August 15th. The successful applicants will be notified by August 24th.

NZIHA reserve the right, based on the standard of teams, not to fill all positions with wildcard applications. The successful wildcard applications will be determined by the performance of the team in their grade in their regional championships.
