TERMS 3 AND 4 – 2020

For Term Four Showcase Performance of “The Pantomime”

The Classes will cover

- Acting skills- voice technique, physical skills, character development, listening to fellow actors/characters.
- Devising and improvisational techniques to develop plot structure, audience engagement and scripting for a performed ‘Pantomime’ to be presented at the end of classes
- Aspects of ‘backstage’ skills and technologies to develop the created project into Performance quality. –These may include designing an appropriate set, make-up, costume and possibly directing elements of the devised script.
- Ensemble skills- working collaboratively towards an end production
- Public presentation/performances of the work at the end of November or early December- with possibly open auditions for extra ‘chorus’ roles (if scripted).

The Tutor: The classes will be run by Drama teacher Bianca Till-

Bianca has been involved in training students for over 15 years, in all aspects of acting performances and theatre skills. She has guided students to successful performances, from Shakespeare scripts to self-devised plays. The content of this weekly programme will challenge participants to develop current skills and learn new ones. Suitable for both experienced and new actors.

- Classes start Term Three- **Thursdays starting 23 July** and continue through to end of Term Four.
- Day of class – Thursdays **4:30pm to 7:30pm** each week at the Boyd Rd Theatre, Waihi.
- Classes work towards devising and performance skills for “The Pantomime”-(title to be determined) performances on dates (to be confirmed) in **late November or early December**
- Thanks to funding from Hauraki District Council “Creative Communities” we can offer these classes at \$14 per class. Commitment required for both terms, due to Performances
= **\$140.00 (inc gst) per term- \$280.00 total.**
- Both term Payments are payable in Term 3 or option to pay half (\$140) by start of Term 3 and half (\$140) by end of Term 3, to continue. Full payment of \$280 is required to secure limited places in class.
- Limit of 12 places available for this class. Applications close 3 July.
