- **Scoping Consultation:**

The Committee launched an [online consultation](#) in March 2019 to gather input on the scope and content of the General Comment. The consultation runs until May 15, and we encourage you to submit a response.

- **Draft Consultation:**

The Committee will launch a further online consultation for specific feedback on the First Draft of the General Comment, likely early in 2020. The First Draft will incorporate feedback from a global children's consultation taking place over Summer 2019.

- **Promoting the Process:**

The Committee hopes to hear from organizations and experts around the world with an interest in the General Comment. We would appreciate any and all efforts to promote the consultation process within your regional and professional networks.

- **Sharing the Result:**

Once the General Comment has been adopted, we will coordinate actions to raise awareness of the new standards. Among other things, we will produce a child-friendly version of the General Comment.

We welcome all contributions to these endeavours, and we would be delighted to have your assistance on this important journey.
