UNIVERSITY OF KENT – Canterbury and Medway Campus

There are no planned open day events at present. However, if you are interested in attending either the Canterbury or Medway campuses, there is an opportunity to book tours.

Tours will need to be booked online prior to visiting.

Tours of the Canterbury campus

Tours take place on Mondays and Fridays (except bank holidays) and are given by Kent students/graduates. Tours depart promptly at 12 noon from the Visitors' Reception in the Registry Building. The tour takes approximately 75 minutes and you will see the main campus facilities including the Templeman Library, the Students' Union, and the Sports Centre.

Visit the [Campus Tours page to book a tour](#). Tours appear after **At Kent Days on the booking form**. They will not run between **17 December 2018 – 11 January 2019**; however, you are still welcome to visit the University and take a [self-guided tour](#) during this period.

The tour does not include visits to individual academic schools or student accommodation, but you can find out more about the course(s) you are interested in by looking at the [course finder](#) and your guide will point out the various types of accommodation during the tour. The campus is made up of 300 acres of parkland, so we recommend comfortable footwear!

Please arrive at the Visitors' Reception in the Registry Building at least five minutes before the tour starts. If for any reason you arrive after the tour has left, you will be provided with a [self-guided tour leaflet](#) so you can still complete your tour. View the [Cancellation Policy](#).

Tours of the Medway campus

Tours of the Medway campus take place on Thursdays and are given by a Kent member of staff/Kent students. Tours depart promptly at 12 noon from the Medway Building. The tour will last approximately 60 minutes and will include the main facilities on campus including the Drill Hall Library and the Student Hub.
