- Encourage all Children in Care and Care Leavers to speak up, voice their opinions and to help shape the services that they receive. We ensure your voices are heard.
- Support the Super Council, Our Children and Young People's Council (OCYPC) and the Young Adult Council (YAC).
- Organise lots of activities for you in the holidays and throughout the year so you can try out new hobbies, make friends and have fun. We even support residential trips.
- Celebrate your successes and achievements at events throughout the year, in our newsletters and on our website.
- Give you extra support when you are going through big changes in your life.
- Support the recruitment of Kent County Council staff and foster carers by making sure that young people's opinions are included in the decision making process.



What We

The **Super Council** is a Children in Care Council in Kent for young people aged 7 - 11 years old.

The Our Children and Young People's Council (OCYPC) is for all Children in Care in Kent aged 11 - 16 years old.

There is also the **Young Adult Council** (YAC) for Children in Care and Care Leavers in Kent aged 16 – 21 years old.

These council groups and their members strive to represent all Children in Care and Care Leavers across Kent. They meet to discuss things that affect them and others who share similar experiences to them. They also get the chance to meet with senior officers of Kent County Council to discuss their views and opinions about the services they receive.

Alongside the Councils, we also run Focus Groups to discuss issues and changes important to Children in Care and Care Leavers. You can come along to these whether you are a member of one of the Councils or not.

Newsletter

We publish newsletters for Children in Care and Care Leavers.

There are three versions; one for primary aged children, one for secondary aged young people and one for young people over the age of 16.

They come out 3 times a year and are full of useful information, latest news and success stories.

We send copies to your social worker and foster carers and editions are available on the Kent Cares Town website too.
