The way we do things: Challenge Cards

You Said:

That you wanted the opportunity to have your voice heard by those who work for Kent County Council, who make the decisions about how you are looked after. You wanted a chance to express your views, opinions and experience of being a child in care or a care leaver.

We Did:

Your VSK Participation Team have worked to create a new "Challenge Card" that you can use to write down and express your views.

The Challenges are agreed by the one of the Kent Children in Care Councils (Super Council, OCYPC or YAC), then are taken to a meeting with Senior Officers who work for Kent County Council for them to discuss and decide upon. They will then report back to us and we will advise you of the outcome.

These challenge cards will help to improve the future services and ways of working with children and young people in care. Without your help, we wouldn't know what we should be doing or things we could change.
