

Waihi East School Board Of Trustees 'SCHOOL CLOSURE Announcement' Wednesday 15 August 2018

As a School Board, we have established that we unanimously support our teachers and the Union in seeking better work conditions for staff and better learning conditions for our students. It is unfortunate that this pursuit looks to include the last resort of a 'Teacher and Principal Strike'.

We will not have ANY staff officially working onsite on the 15 August. Waihi East School will be Officially CLOSED.

We understand that this action by the Union, Teachers and the Board, could be an inconvenience for parents, students and teachers, but please ensure you **DO NOT SEND** your child/ren to school on WEDNESDAY 15 AUGUST.

Please keep in mind that teachers are taking action to:

- · Reduce Class sizes
- Increase support for at risk/ struggling learners
- A pay increase to:
 - -Make the career more attractive we are facing a huge teacher shortage nationwide.
 - -Ensure quality teachers stay in the profession.
- Increase ability for teachers to pursue professional learning and time to plan and prepare for quality learning programmes.



KIDSCAN GO CRAZY HAIR FUNDRAISER


KidsCan support Waihi East School with food, tissues, nit treatment and raincoats.




FREE EAR CLINIC SERIVICE FOR CHILDREN
