Learning focus

Further to our segment on Assessment and Learning from our last newsletter, you will be beginning to see the way we document children's learning is being modernised. Instead of a lengthy story focused on one activity, we will now be sharing a wider variety of learning experiences in smaller snapshots. These will show the progression of the individual child's learning journey and include goals for the child to extend them along with parent's aspirations.

Recently the Preschool teachers have been looking at our value of 'positive social behaviour' through taking turns, working together to achieve a common goal, and friendly behaviour.

In the Nursery the children have been exploring the garden, and engaging in lots of art and messy play activities. This relates to our learning value of 'being curious'.

Currently the Preschool is looking at 'self help, and independence' and the Nursery 'physical activity'.
