Sun Safety

As we approach summer weather we are planning our sun safety at York Place. Shortly we will be putting up our sunshades to provide more shelter outdoors.

Sunhats will soon become a daily requirement for outside play. Please ensure you child has their own clearly named wide brimmed hat so they can be well protected. Caps are not suitable as they do not provide any sun protection for the ears and neck. Shoulders need to be covered with clothing. Shoes need to securely attach to your children's feet for running, biking and playing such as sneakers or sandals (no jandals please unless they have a strap around the back).

Sunscreen will also be needed daily over the summer even on overcast days. The date for this to start is likely to be after Labour weekend. Please ensure your child has sunscreen on when they arrive so they are ready for outdoor play covering their face, neck, arms, and legs. We provide sunscreen to which will be reapplied during the day. We use 'Smart365' which has a 50 SPF. If your child has allergies please supply a clearly named sunscreen for them to use while here. Thank you for your support keeping your children sun safe while at York Place.
