- If the obligations under the *Associations Incorporation Act* are not complied with the Association can be wound up.

- If your application is accepted you are entitled to inspect and make a copy of the rules (constitution) of the association under section28 of the *Associations Incorporation Act*.

If you application for membership is rejected by the Committee: You may give notice of your intention to appeal within 14 days of being advised of the rejection (rule 5)4). The Association, in a general meeting, no later than the next annual general meeting, must confirm or set aside the decision of the Committee rejection you application, after giving you a reasonable opportunity to be heard or to make written representations to the general meeting (rule 5(5)).
