TENEBRAE

Tenebrae ("shadows") is the name popularly given to services in the medieval church held on evenings preceding Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. Tenebrae combines the chief elements of the ancient services, namely the extinguishing of candles during scripture readings balanced with responses of musical beauty.
