

FOLLOWING OUR MEAL - A CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

Hymn "An Upper Room did Our Lord Prepare" (Tune: O waly waly)

1 *An upper room did our Lord prepare
for those he loved until the end:
and his disciples still gather there
to celebrate their risen Friend.*

One: We are bound to thank, praise, glorify,

for our ancestors and for us.

All: To freedom,

All: to festivity,

One: from darkness

All: to great light

One: from bondage

All: to redemption

WORDS OF INSTITUTION

One: While they were eating their Passover meal,

Jesus took a loaf of bread,

and after blessing it he broke it,

gave it to his friends, and said,

"Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you

Do this in remembrance of me."

Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks

he gave it to them, saying,

"This cup that is poured out for you

is the new covenant in my blood

which is poured out for many

for the forgiveness of sins.

I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine

until the reign of God comes."

The cut bread located on the tables is passed around and held until all are served

One: The Bread of Life

All: Amen.

We eat the bread at the same time together

The wine and grape juice (grape juice is located on the table)

One: The Cup of blessing

All: Amen.

We take a sip of juice or wine at the same time together

PRAYER FOLLOWING COMMUNION

**Patient God, we have received the elements of bread and wine.
We have come to the table, imperfect, flawed.**

Yet You, In Christ, receive us and offer to us healing and hope.

Forgive our waywardness. Heal our brokenness.

Challenge us to live lives of faithfulness and discipleship. Amen.

sent out to serve, as he was sent.*

*4 No end there is! We depart in peace.
